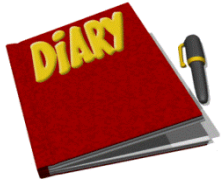

Can you help us with GDPR?

Since the new regulations came into place last May we have put many things into place to comply with the new laws. We have completed an audit, we have introduced Privacy Notices, we have agreed and issued our overall Policy and many other items. There are however still things we must do, eg we need a designated person to coordinate all aspects of GDPR, we need to organize training and we need to keep everything properly logged and up-to-date.

So we have an opportunity for somebody to pick this up. We assume that many people now have experience of GDPR with other organisations, big and small and if this is you we could really benefit from your understanding and guidance. The person would need to have good computer and administration skills, have access to a computer and the confidence to use "cloud" based file storage systems.
