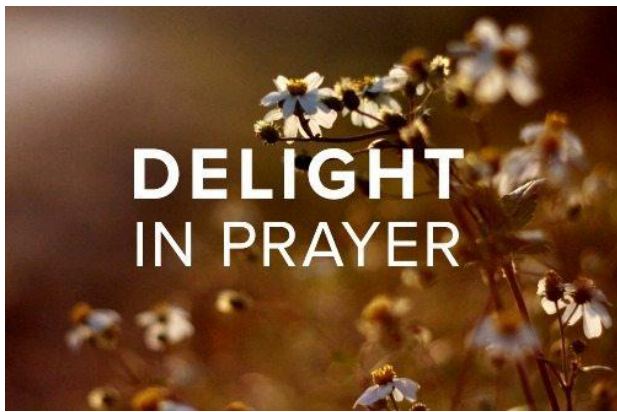
**DNA: Identity Conference
